T.I.M.E. Association in partnership with L'Oréal: Double Degree scholarship programme





The T.I.M.E. Association, with the support from L'Oréal, is proud to launch the "T.I.M.E. - L'Oréal Double Degree scholarships". These scholarships aim to support students in financial need, facilitating their participation in double degree programmes between two T.I.M.E. institutions.

T.I.M.E. Members are tasked to **nominate their candidates** and submit the application to the Secretary General of the T.I.M.E. Association at <u>secretary.general@timeassociation.org.</u> Each T.I.M.E. member institution may nominate **one outgoing student**;

Scholarship overview:

- Total budget: € 20,000
- Amount per scholarship: Up to €10,000 over the total duration of the T.I.M.E. Double Degree programme;

Eligibility criteria:

- Open exclusively to double degree students between two T.I.M.E. institutions;
- Selection based on financial needs;
- Motivation.

Application file:

- The application should include:
 - a motivation letter explaining the student's decision to pursue a double degree and how this scholarship will contribute to the realisation of their academic and professional project;
 - o a support letter from their home institution;
 - o **a detailed budget plan**: The budget plan should outline the need for the scholarship, and any other financial support the applicant receives.

Selection Process:

Step 1: Application Pre-selection

- Application period: April 2nd May 16th, 2024;
- <u>Requirements</u>: T.I.M.E. Members are tasked to nominate their candidates and submit the application to the Secretary General, T.I.M.E. Association at <u>secretary.general@timeassociation.org</u>
- Each T.I.M.E. member institution may nominate one outgoing student;

Step 2: Jury proceedings

- <u>Preliminary selection</u>: The T.I.M.E. Selection Committee will meet online on **June 4**,
 2024 from 9 AM 12 PM, CET, and conduct an initial review of the applications and shortlist at most 15 applications;
- <u>Interviews</u>: The T.I.M.E. Selection Committee and L'Oréal representatives will conduct interviews on **June 14, 2024** from 10 AM – 1 PM, CET, dividing into three panels to assess 5 candidates each;
- <u>Deliberation</u>: Following interviews, the T.I.M.E. Selection Committee and L'Oréal representatives will decide and select the final scholarship recipients;
- Notification: Final results will be announced by late June.

<u>Scholarship award ceremony</u>: Scheduled during the T.I.M.E. General Assembly at Polytechnique Montréal, Canada, from October 16-18, 2024.

Candidate commitments:

Candidates should engage in regular, non-binding exchanges with their L'Oréal mentor for career advice without obligation to join the company.
