

International mobility opportunities for students at **UNIVERSITY OF SEVILLE**



Internationalisation at University of Seville

Internationalising its student's training is one of University of Seville's top priorities, its motive forces being teaching in English, international double degrees and a dynamic mobility policy that enables our students to undertake study and internship stays worldwide.

There are two principal sources of finance for these mobilities. EU mobilities are financed by the Erasmus+ Programme, while mobility to non-EU destinations is financed by University of Seville's Own Teaching/Learning Plan.

As University of Seville holds several different calls for both domestic and international mobility, it is a good idea to consult the website frequently.



International Centre

University of Seville's International Centre is located in Avenida de Ciudad Jardín and it is here where most of the University's domestic and international mobility programmes are administered, be they incoming or outgoing.

The International Centre is also the Welcome Office for foreign students. It has become a meeting point for the over 5,000 international students that study at University of Seville each year.



Mobility Opportunities for Students at University of Seville

Mobility stays can be undertaken in different ways:

What is a student mobility?

This is when undergraduate, Master's or Doctoral students undertake part of their studies at a different domestic or international university. In this type of mobility, recognition of the studies undertaken in the destination university is guaranteed. In the case of Doctoral mobility, students undertake a research stay, ideal for obtaining an international mention.

What is internship mobility?

This is when undergraduate, Master's or Doctoral students undertake an internship in a business, institution, research centre or university.

Such internships can be curricular or extracurricular.

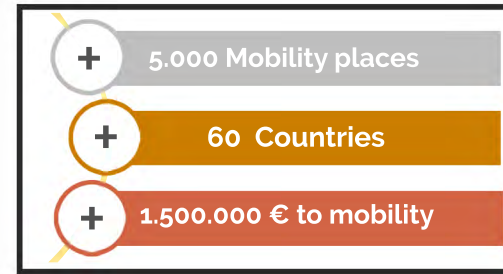
- Curricular internships are those provided for in the syllabus. They are assigned ECTS credits which are computed during the undergraduate or Master's degrees.
- Extracurricular internships are not provided for in the syllabus and stays can last for up to six months.

In the case of Doctoral studies, students can undertake a research stay.

What is an international double degree?

A number of the undergraduate and Master's degrees that you can study at University of Seville benefit from a double qualification agreement with another international university. This means that students studying a double international qualification will be awarded two qualifications: one from Universidad de Sevilla and one from the partner university.

Depending on the degree requirements, and whether it is an undergraduate or Master's degree, studying for a double international qualification entails a study stay in the partner university of between 6 months and two years.



What is a mobility call?

Every year University of Seville offers its students mobility places and grants through its mobility calls. Admission onto these places and to the grants take place according to the principles of equality of opportunities, transparency, evaluation criteria based on academic performance, etc.



Mobility programmes and calls

Most of the international mobility offer is concentrated into University of Seville's convocatoria general de movilidad internacional General Call for International Mobility. This call is for places in universities worldwide; for destinations financed by the Erasmus+ Programme, as well as for destinations in the rest of the world financed by Universidad de Sevilla.

This call also includes the places for double international qualifications.

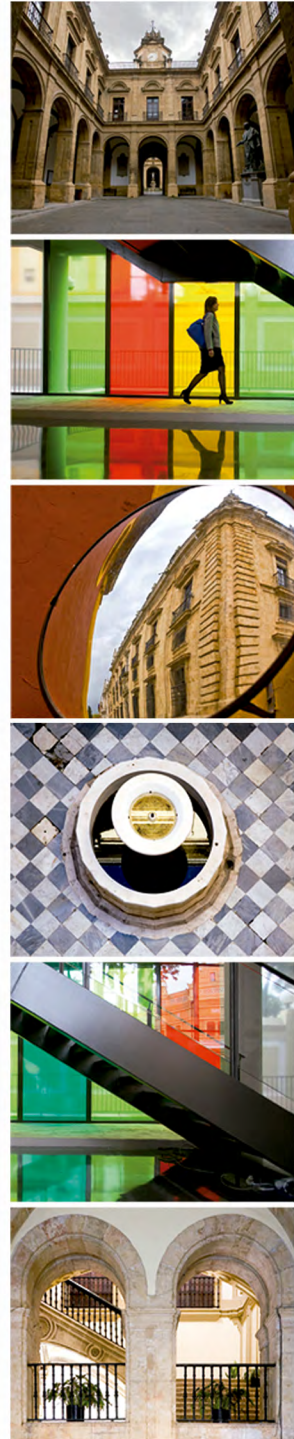
Mobility calls and programmes

The other pillar of University of Seville's mobility offer is its convocatoria de prácticas internacionales, or Call for International Internships. This is mainly financed by the Erasmus+ Programme, with some aid from University of Seville for non-Erasmus destinations.

Under the INFHAE Mentoring Programme there are other opportunities for Doctoral students, such as the call for Thesis co-tutoring, research training stays and research stays.

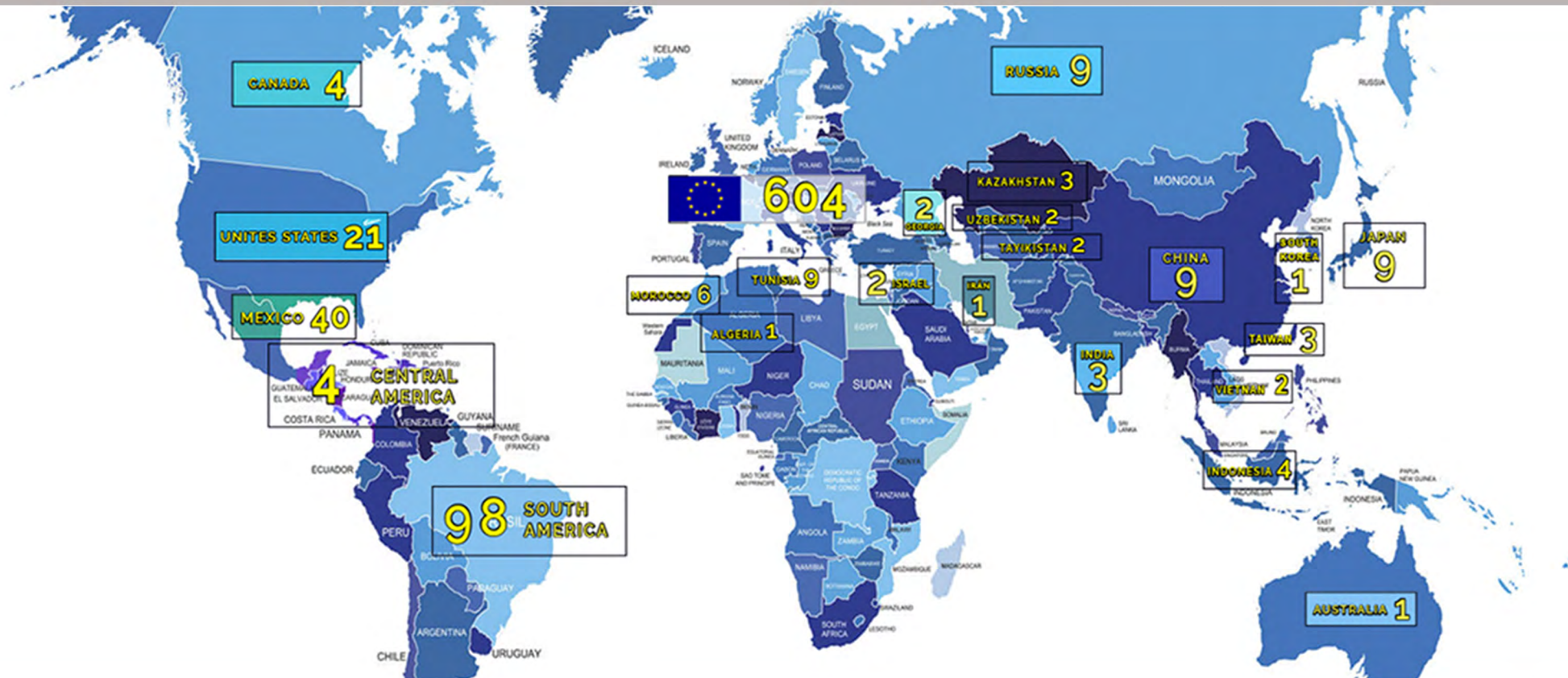


Over 800 partner universities worldwide

As well as the offer in the general call, University of Seville also has specific calls for programmes with US universities. Students of some of our degrees can undertake a study semester in the University of Pennsylvania.

Students from our University's Faculty of Geography and History who are in the final year of their undergraduate degree, or enrolled on the Master's degree can undertake a minimum one-month stay as part of their Dissertation or Master's Thesis in US universities that have been selected by the Council on International Education Exchange.

Finally, Doctoral students from Universidad de Sevilla have the opportunity to enjoy a research stay at Cornell University or at the University of California



Students enrolled on the Faculty of Educational Sciences' Primary Education or Infant Education degrees can undertake a 4-week teaching practice period in Schools selected by the University of North Texas.

Also of interest is the Teaching Assistant Programme. This is open to students enrolled on the Faculty of Philology's official Master's Degree and to Doctoral students on its Doctorate in Philological Studies. Those selected will spend a stay lasting one academic year working as a Spanish teacher in the universities of North Carolina, Indiana, and Idaho.

Finally, for students at the Faculty of Economic and Business Sciences and the Higher School of IT Engineering, there are Summer Courses at the University of Virginia's College at Wise.

Specific short-stay programmes and agreements



As well as the destinations offered in the above calls, there are also specific programmes with Latin-American universities. Within the Agricultura para el Desarrollo Sostenible (AGRIDESO) Network of Agriculture for Sustainable Development, students enrolled on any qualification in the Higher School of Agronomic Engineering can undertake their Dissertation over a 5-month period in one of the network's universities in Argentina, Chile, or Peru.

Students enrolled on the Medicine Degree can undertake their paediatrics and External Practicum over a three-month period in one of the Bolivian or Peruvian universities in the *Pediatría Social y Salud Global Infantil* (PEDSOCSGI) Network of Social Paediatrics and Global Child Health. Brazil's Universidade Federal de Minas Gerais offers help for participants in its Summer Courses .

At a more global level, final-year degree and Master's Degree students enrolled in the Faculty of Philology can also obtain financial aid to undertake a short one-month stay in order to do their Dissertation or Master's Thesis, as part of Agreements between University of Seville and other Universities.

There are also final-year teaching assistant posts in Rumania, Germany or SISU University in China through the DAAD Programme.



Domestic mobility programme and call



The domestic mobility programme, known by its acronym, SICUE, is aimed at those Degree and Double Degree students who have a minimum of 45 credits, offering them the chance to undertake a study stay in another Spanish University and with full academic recognition.

Presently, the programme has no source of finance, yet Universidad de Sevilla is committed to financing 50 grants itself.



External, non-University of Seville Programmes

As well as University of Seville's own mobility programmes, there are other programmes and sources of finance for student wishing to embark on the adventure of studying elsewhere.

Below is a list of the main external mobility programmes available to Universidad de Sevilla students.

Banco Santander Grants

Each year Banco Santander awards a series of grants to Universidad de Sevilla students whose application in the General International Mobility Call have been successful, supplementing the financing offered by the Call. To apply for the Banco Santander Grant, students must fulfil its established requirements.

Remember

Throughout the academic year and in line with the financing that Universidad de Sevilla obtains from other public bodies and private institutions, other mobility calls will be made. It is a good idea to consult our website regularly.

For stays in non-Spanish speaking countries, knowledge of the teaching language is required for admission. Each university specifies its own minimum required TOEFL score.

Students will have to research the score for their own particular destination and start preparations for the test from day 1 at University of Seville.

Each University of Seville Centre has a Vice-Dean in charge of International Relations and/or mobility, as well as administrative staff.

They are there to advise students on important academic and administrative questions concerning international mobility. Don't be shy! Consult them.
